PRIVATE LESSON PROGRAM

We have been fortunate to obtain commitments from several highly qualified instrumental teachers to give private lessons in the MHS Music Suite after school and evenings. This is offered as a convenience to the students. The Music Department and/or the Marshfield schools have no financial interest in this program-only educational interest. In exchange for using the school facilities, these teachers agree to accept the established rate of \$23.00 per ½ hour lesson. For most of these teachers this rate is considerably less than they receive teaching at a conservatory or in their home. This fee is payable directly to the teacher, monthly, at the first lesson of each month.

We cannot emphasize enough the value, indeed the importance, of private lessons. In Marshfield our students receive group instrumental music lessons through grade 5 only. After that, all instruction is in the form of large group ensembles (Band, Orchestra and Chorus). While private lessons are not a requirement for participation in the school music program at any level, those students who study privately are much better equipped to take advantage of the various musical opportunities that are available to them in the middle and high school.

You will be contacted directly by the private teacher to schedule a lesson time. Generally the teachers fill up their schedules quickly, so don't delay.
